Newsletter Dedication

We are dedicating this newsletter to one of our own. Spec. Joseph W. Dimock II graduated from Warren Township High School. Joey enlisted in the United States Army in August 2007. He was serving his second deployment to Afghanistan and had previously served a deployment to Iraq. Joey completed both Basic Combat Training and the Basic Airborne Course at Fort Benning, Georgia, and in September of 2008 he completed the Ranger Indoctrination Program.

He was killed in the line of duty in Afghanistan last month at age 21.

Joey's awards and decorations include: Ranger Tab, Combat Infantryman Badge and Parachutist Badge; National Defense Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and the Army Service Ribbon. He was posthumously awarded the Bronze Star and the Meritorious Service Medal.

Joey's parents, Joseph and Ellen Dimock, and his two brothers, Louis and Michael, still live in Wildwood. Joey was an Eagle Scout and an active member of Wildwood Presbyterian Church.
